

HOUSING AND HOMELESSNESS SUPPORT



At Roseberry Qld we are committed to enabling people to break out of the cycle of disadvantage and poverty by having a safe and sustainable place to live and grow. We provide a range of housing support from crisis response to long term housing and manage a property portfolio of over 190 homes.

YOUTH HOMELESSNESS

We operate youth Shelters in Gladstone and Rockhampton. Providing short-term supported accommodation for young people aged 16 – 25 years who are experiencing homelessness.

The shelters operate 365 days a year.

Staff work to enhance the dignity and independence of young people while recognising the importance of family. Young people are provided with basic living skills, information, referral and advocacy to broaden the young person's support network and ensure their identified needs are met. All referral pathways are welcome.

AFFORDABLE ACCOMMODATION

Furnished studio cabins for working members of the gladstone community earning in the low to middle income bracket. These properties are owned and managed by Roseberry QLD.

MOBILE TENANCY SUPPORT

Offers tailored assistance to young people aged 16–25 living independently, helping them maintain tenancies through emotional support, advocacy, referrals, and practical help.

CRISIS ACCOMMODATION PROGRAM

For singles and families aged 16-25 in need of supported accommodation. CAP provides short-term housing and support for people in Rockhampton and Gladstone, focusing on developing independent living skills and securing long-term accommodation. Properties managed by Roseberry Qld.

LONG TERM COMMUNITY HOUSING

Properties are owned by the Dept of Housing and managed by Roseberry Qld. When vacant properties arise, Roseberry are sent suitable applicants from the Department to commence intake process for a new tenancy. To register for social housing contact the Department by phone: (07) 4899 2400.

EDUCATION AND EMPLOYMENT HOUSING PROGRAM

Properties are owned by the dept of housing and managed by Roseberry Qld. Designed for First Nations workers and students relocating from a remote community to a regional centre such as Gladstone to work or study. To be eligible, you must meet the social housing eligibility criteria and provide proof of study or ongoing employment.

THE DIGNITY HUB

Located at 21 Dawson Road Gladstone, providing free access to:

- Laundry & bathroom facilities
- Kitchenette
- Food hampers and a hot meal
- Information and referral to services

IMMEDIATE HOUSING RESPONSE

Provides short-term and temporary refuge accommodation assistance for Queenslanders experiencing, or at imminent risk of homelessness. The IHR is delivered by government funded services and Roseberry Qld provide this service for individuals and couples in Gladstone.
